Venezuela (Sep 28?)

Cooperation pact to expand technical cooperation for geological and mining exploration. The cooperation has three aspects: The first is the interpretation of aeromagnetic data. It will be carried out jointly by Chinese and Venezuelan experts using Chinese technology over a small area of between 1,500 and 2,000 square kilometers. Venezuela will send reports of the survey to China before the end of this year. Geochemical prospecting will be implemented. Venezuelan scientists will be sent to China to improve their knowledge of the country's chemical prospecting methods and technology and of Chinese field studies. China will also help to prepare a geological map of the Guayana iron mines. The cooperation in the three sectors is part of a scientific and technical accord on mining and geology signed between Venezuela's energy and mining ministry and China's Geology and Mineral Resources Ministry in November 1988. Cai was the widow of Li Fuchun (member of the CCP Politburo, 1956-67). She was a member of the CCP 6th-11th Central Committees (1928-82) and president of the Women's Federation (1949-78).

Cao Pengsheng 曹 蓬 生
Identified as polit. commissar of Lanzhou Mil. Region. (Lanzhou Radio, Jul 5, 1990; cit. SWB, Jul 9, 1990)
Born in 1930, Cao joined the PLA in 1946. He graduated from the PLA Political Academy in 1979 and successively served in Shandong Military District becoming its political commissar in 1986. He was elected member of the Central Discipline Inspection Commission under the CCP Central Committee in Nov 1987 and was appointed major-general in Sep 1988.

Cao Zeyi 曹 泽 毅
Removed from his positions as vice-minister of public health. (XNA, Sep 29, 1990)

Chen Jinhua 陈 锦 华
Appointed minister of the State Commission for Restructuring the Economic System. (XNA, Sep 7, 1990)
Chen was born in 1929 and studied in the Soviet Union. He served as vice-mayor of Shanghai (1979-83) and then as general manager and president of the China National Petrochemical Corporation.

Chen Shuqing 陈 树 清
Identified as commander of Fujian Military District. (Fuzhou Radio, Aug 28, 1990; cit. SWB, Sep 19, 1990)
Chen is a newcomer.

Ding Weizhi 丁 伟 志
Removed from his position as vice-president of the Academy of Social Sciences. (XNA, Sep 29, 1990)

Duanmu Zheng 端木 正
Appointed vice-president of the People's Court. (XNA, Sep 7, 1990)
Duanmu has been vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Guangdong Province before.

Feng Lanming 冯 兰 明
Appointed deputy secretary-general of NPC Standing Committee. (XNA, Sep 7, 1990)
Feng has been deputy director of the Government Offices Administration Bureau before.

Li Jiulong 李 九 龙
Appointed deputy director of the General Logistics Department under the PLA General Staff. (Hongkong Tangtai, Sep 8, 1990; cit. SWB, Sep 27, 1990)

Li, born in 1929, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee and lieutenant-general, had been commander of Jinan Military Region from 1985 until May 1990.

Liu Heng 刘 珩
Appointed vice-minister of textile industry. (XNA, Sep 29, 1990)
In 1956 Liu graduated from Huadong Textile Industry College and successively worked in textile industry factories. In 1983 he became vice-mayor of Sha City in Hubei Province.

Liu Hezhang 刘 鹤 章
Appointed deputy auditor-general of the Auditing Administration. (XNA, Sep 29, 1990)
Liu was born in 1941 and later graduated from college. From 1965 to 1982 he served in Xinjiang.

Lü Derun 吕 德 润
Appointed deputy director of the Counsellors Office under the State Council. (XNA, Sep 29, 1990)
Lü is a non-party figure and has worked more than half a century with TKP and its Hongkong branch.

Nie Dajiang 聂 大江
Removed from his position as vice-minister of cinema, radio and television. (XNA, Sep 29, 1990)

Pan Beilei (f) 潘 蓓 蕾
Appointed vice-minister of light industry. (XNA, Sep 29, 1990)
Pan was born in 1941 in Taiwan and later received a university education. She is an engineer who achieved results in brewery and other light industrial research.
