Asian Development Bank (Nov 29)

The ADB approved a loan of 50 million US\$ for an Agricultural Bank of China project. The loan has a term of 15 years, including a three-year grace period. The interest rate will be determined in accordance with the bank's pool-based variable lending rate system. The main objective of the loan is to support the small and medium-sized rural enterprises in Shandong, Guangdong, Jilin, Jiangsu and Fujian provinces. In addition, ADB will provide a technical assistance grant of 480,000 US\$ to strengthen ABC's institutional capacity for project lending and investment analysis at provincial and county levels. ADB also approved the execution of a technical assistance grant of 2.3 million US\$ for a project of developing water resources in Hainan province.

China will use Soviet transmitters to broad-

cast to Iraq, Saudi Arabia, the Persian Gulf region, Turkey, Britain, France, and other countries. The protocol is for two years, but it will be extended automatically if neither side terminates it. (Moscow Radio, Nov 18, 1990; cit. SWB, Nov 21, 1990)

Thailand (Nov 29)

A Minutes of the 6th Meeting of the Sino-Thai Economic Cooperation Committee;

B Protocol of import and export commodities for 1991. Under it, China will mainly import rice, raw sugar, rubber and cassava and cassava products from Thailand in 1991. Its principal exports to Thailand will include crude oil and refined oil, coal, cotton, machinery and electrical products, and medicine. - The volume of bilateral trade in 1978 was only 144 million US\$. It grew to 1.2 billion US\$ in 1989 and is expected to keep such level in 1990.

Appointed vice-minister of Machine-Building and Electronics Industry. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Bao has been chairman of the Planning and Economic Commission under Sichuan Province before.

Chen Shi-neng 陈士能

Resigns as vice-minister of light industry. (RMRB, Nov 9, 1990; cit. SWB, Nov 26, 1990)

Ding Guan'gen 丁关根

Resigns as vice-minister of the State Planning Commission and as director of the Taiwan Affairs Office under the State Council. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Appointed director of the Department of Unity Front Work under the CCP Central Committee (XNA, Nov 30, 1990)

Ding belongs as the only alternate member to the Politburo of the CCP.

Ge Hongsheng 葛洪升

Appointed acting governor of Zhejiang Province. (Hangzhou Radio, Nov 11, 1990; cit. SWB, Nov 22, 1990)

Ge was born in 1931 in Junan County, Shandong Province. After service in the field of electric power he became Party secretary of Ningbo City in 1985 and alternate member of the CCP 13th Central Committee in 1987.

Gu Jinchi 雇金池

Appointed secretary of Gansu Province CP. (Lanzhou Radio, Nov 27, 1990; cit. SWB, Nov 29, 1990)

Gu was born in 1932 in Xiong County, Hebei Province. After service in machine tool plants in Beijing and Zigong he became vice-governor of Sichuan Province in 1983, member of the CCP 13th Central Committee in 1987 and deputy secretary of Gansu CP the following year.

Hui Yongzheng 惠永正

Appointed vice-minister of the State Science and Technology Commission. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Hui has been director of the Shanghai Institute of Organic Chemistry under the Academy of Sciences before.

Ji Pengfei 姬鹏飞

Resigns from his position as director of the Hongkong and Macao Affairs Office under the State Council. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Jia Qinglin 贾庆林

Appointed acting governor of Fujian Province. (XNA, Nov 21, 1990)

Jia was born in 1940 in Jiaohu County, Hebei Province. After graduation from Hebei Engineering College in 1962 he served as technician in the 1st Ministry of Machine-Building (1962-69), as general manager of the China National Machinery Import and Export Corporation (1978-83), director of Taiyuan Heavy Machinery Plant (1983-85), deputy secretary of Fujian CP (since 1987) and as vice-governor of Fujian since July 1990.

Li Changchun 李昌春

Elected deputy secretary of Henan Province CP. (XNA, Nov 13, 1990)

Li, a member of the CCP Central Committee, has been acting governor of Henan Province since June this year.

Li Dezhu 李德洙

Appointed vice-minister of the State Nationalities Affairs Commission. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Li was born in 1944 in Wangqing County, Jilin Province. He belongs to the Korean minority. After graduation in political science from Yanbian University he served as a cadre of the Communist Youth League in Jilin from 1973-82. Successively he serves as Party secretary in his home county and then in Yanbian Korean Autonomous Prefecture. He became an alternate member of the 12th CCP Central Committee in May 1985 and a member of the 13th CCP in November 1987.

Li Hou 李后

Relieved from his position as deputy director of the State Hongkong and Macau Affairs Office. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Lin Yinghai 林英海

Elected deputy secretary of Henan Province CP. (XNA, Nov 13, 1990)

Lin was born in 1932 in Taiqian County, Henan Province. He graduated from Beijing Teachers University in 1963 and served 1976-83 as Party secretary in his home county. Since 1984 he has been secretary of the Discipline Inspection Commission under Henan CP.

Lu Ping 鲁平

Appointed director of the Hongkong and Macau Affairs Office under the State Council. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Lu was born in 1929 in Langzhong County, Sichuan Province. In 1947 he graduated from the Agricultural College under St. John's University in Shanghai. 1949-52 he served in the China Welfare Society and 1958-59 as deputy editor-in-chief of *China Reconstructs*. In 1978 he became secretary-general of the State Hongkong and Macau Affairs Office and in 1987 its deputy director.

Wang Fang 王芳

Appointed chairman of the State Anti-Narcotics Committee. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Since Apr 1987 Wang has been minister of public security and since Apr 1988 state councillor.

Wang Min (f) 王珉

Relieved from her position as vice-minister of chemical industry. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Wang Zhaoguo 王兆国

Relieved from his position as governor of Fujian Province. (XNA, Nov 21,

1990) and appointed director of the Taiwan Affairs Office under the State Council (XNA, Nov 23, 1990). Since Sep 1982 Wang has been member of the CCP Central Committee.

Wu Jichuan 吴基传
Elected deputy secretary of Henan Province CP. (XNA, Nov 13, 1990)

Wu was born in 1937 in Changning County, Hunan Province. In 1959 he graduated from Beijing Institute of Posts and Telecommunications. 1978-84 he served in bureaux of the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications and became its vice-minister in Nov 1984.

Yan Keqiang 严克强
Appointed vice-minister of water resources. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)

Yan was a newcomer when elected deputy for Jiangsu Province to the NPC for the first time in May, 1983.

Yü Wen 郁文
Appointed vice-president of the Academy of Social Sciences. (RMRB, Nov 9, 1990; cit. SWB, Nov 26, 1990)

Yü was born in 1918 in Mancheng County, Hebei Province. 1937-38 he studied at the Anti-Japanese Military and Political College of the Communists in Yan'an. The following years until 1953 he worked for various newspapers in Shanxi and Xinjiang. In 1953 he became director of the Cadres Department of the Academy of Sciences, in 1956 its deputy secretary-general and in 1965 the director of its Political Department (until 1967). In 1973 he was reactivated as deputy secretary-general of the Academy of Sciences, becoming its secretary-general in 1978 (until 1982). 1982-85 he served as deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee. In 1986 he became member of the Standing Committee of the NPC and in 1988 vice-chairman of its Nationalities Affairs Committee.

Zhang Dejiang 张德江
Relieved from his position as vice-minister of civil affairs. (XNA, Nov 23, 1990)
