Namibia (Mar 27)

Cultural agreement covering the fields of culture, education, science, health, sports and mass media. (XNA, Mar 27, 1991)

New Zealand (Mar 20)

Memorandum on strengthening academic cooperation. According to it, the research cooperation will involve exchanging scientists and information on science and technology and implementing cooperative research and development projects. (XNA, Mar 20, 1991)

North Korea (Mar 06) Trade protocol for 1991. (XNA, Mar 6, 1991)

Philippines (Mar 08)

Trade protocol for 1991. According to it, the 1991 targeted volume for a bilateral exchange of goods worth 400-450 million U.S. dollars initially. Major commodities China will import from the Philippines this year include phosphatic and compound fertilizer, coconut oil, coffee and coffee beans, fresh bananas, chrome ore, plywood and cashew nuts. Among the major commodities the Philippines will import from China this year are crude oil, coal, machinery, textiles, equipment, electrical products, steel billets, cotton, cement, mineral and mineral products. Crude oil accounted for the bulk of the Philippine imports from China. Bilateral trade peaked in 1985 when the Philippines imported 276.08 million U.S. dollars worth of goods from China and exported 79.79 million U.S. dollars worth of goods to China. (XNA, Mar 8, 1991)


