General soft loan agreement between the People's Construction Bank of China (PCBC) and the Instituto de Credito of the Kingdom of Spain. The agreement will make the Spanish loans, the government loans in particular, more accessible to Chinese construction projects. The PCBC, the main arm for the country's key state capital construction investment, for the first time borrowed a total of 76.46 million US\$ worth of mixed loans last year for the Tianjin ethylene project; among the loans, 38.23 million US\$ were soft loans provided by the Spanish government. This year, the PCBC will siphon more loans from Spain, including about 300 million US\$ government soft loans for the Wuhan Iron and Steel Company.
