AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Algeria (Feb 28)

Agreement on China to give Algeria a reactor of 15,000 kW and the heavy water and fuel it requires. The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) has empowered its director-general, Hans Blix, to sign a treaty with Algeria whereby China will provide Algeria with a nuclear reactor for research. (XNA, Feb 28, 1992)

Bahrain (Feb 26)

Summary of talks on cultural exchanges 1992-94. The document stipulates the items of exchanges between the two countries in culture and art, information, education, sports and youth. (XNA, Feb 26, 1992)

Hongkong (Feb 26)

Agreement between the China Council for Promotion of International Trade and the Hongkong Trade Development Council to reinforce bilateral economic cooperation. According to it, a high-level conference will be held biennially between senior representatives of both sides to review and discuss plans of cooperation. Both parties agreed to exchange publications and information on the latest economic, trade, financial, industrial and technological developments. They will provide information on each other's import and export trade in order to improve understanding of the market direction and trading situation of their respective business communities. Seminars will be held for businessmen to exchange views and to reinforce this cooperation. (XNA, Feb 26, 1992)

India (Feb 27)

Protocoll on cooperation in the field of education for 1992-93. (XNA, Feb 27, 1992)

Indonesia (Feb 24)

Memorandum on media cooperation. It says that the two governments agreed to exchange experience from the use of advanced technology of information especially on radio, film and television. The two governments also agreed to exchange radio and television broadcasting materials and films. (XNA, Feb 24, 1992)

Kazakhstan (Feb 26)

In addition to a joint communiqué, several documents were signed. They are:

- A Minutes of talks between the civil aviation administrations of the two countries;
- B minutes of talks between the office of border port affairs under the Chinese state council and the Kazakhstan foreign ministry on opening border ports;
- C minutes of talks between the two ministries of communications on automobile transportation;
- D minutes of talks between the Chinese ministry of railways and the Kazakhstan ministry of communications on strengthening cooperation in railway transportation;
- E agreement between the two governments on the passage of citizens between the two countries;

F agreement on China providing commodity loans to Kazakhstan;

G agreement between the two governments on establishing a committee of economic, trade, scientific and technological cooperation;

H travel agreement. Under it, citizens of the two countries who hold diplomatic and service passports or those holding general passports but on official business are not required to obtain visas when traveling to the other country. The agreement becomes effective 30 days from today. (XNA, Feb 26, 1992)

Myanmar (Feb 15)

Notes exchange on China to construct a satellite ground station. Under it, China will send two teams to study the construction of a satellite ground station and a steam-powered generating plant in Mawlamyine, capital of south-east Myanmar's Mon state, and to provide necessary spare parts there. The costs for the construction of the satellite ground station and spare parts for the power generating plant will be covered by an interest-free loan amounting to 50 million renminbi yuan (about 9.5 million US\$) in accordance with the economic and technical cooperation agreement between Myanmar and China. North Korea (Feb 29)

Implementation program for 1992-93 for the cooperation agreement on public health and medical sciences. According to the program, the two countries will exchange technical information and medical samples and will exchange study groups and internes. Under the program, cooperation will be promoted between medical institutions of the two sides, and each side will provide medical treatment to patients of the other side. (XNA, Feb 29, 1992)

Pakistan (Feb 22 ?)

Two supplementary agreements concerning establishment of a 300-megawatt nuclear power plant at Chashma near Mianwali. The original agreement for the purchase of a nuclear power plant from China was finalized in Beijing in December 1991. (Islamabad Radio, Feb 22, 1992; cit. SWB, Feb 29, 1992)

Portugal (Feb 03)

Agreement on investment protection. The agreement, with a validity period of 10 years, says that to expand Sino-Portuguese economic cooperation, the two governments shall encourage and protect investment in each other's country and shall create favorable conditions for this endeavour.

Portugal (Feb 16)

Agreement on sports cooperation for 1992. Under it, the Portuguese side will send technicians to China to study the organizational work of high-level sports, the construction of stadiums and gymnasiums and the development of sports for the handicapped. The Chinese side will send diving, acrobatic gymnastics and table tennis experts to Portugal to provide short-term training to Portuguese athletes.

Two trade contracts worth 360 million US\$. Under the contracts, China National Technical Import and Export Corporation will import equipment and technology worth 320 million dollars from Spanish Technica Reunidas S.A.

ECONOMIC AID****Myanmar**

The China-aided 2,900-m rail and road bridge in Yangon is expected to be completed in 1993. The total length of the Yangon-Tanyin rail-road bridge is 2,938 meters while that of the main span is 1,844.4 meters, 200 meters longer than that of the famous Nanjing Yangze river bridge in China. The bridge project has entered a comprehensive construction stage as it has completed the erection of 10-aperture steel trusses of the main span. The construction project started three and a half years ago.

Ethiopia

China has granted Ethiopia a package of medicine valued at some 130,000 US\$ to help meet the war-torn country's urgent need for medical aid.
