AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Chile (May 23)

Minutes of the 12th meeting of the China-Chile Economic and Commercial Joint Committee. (XNA, May 24, 1991)

Chile (May 31)

Executive program for cultural exchange in 1991-93. This will cover exchange of visits by delegations in press and publication, broadcasting and television, and education and culture. China and Chile also will promote mutual transfer of books and TV programmes and university-to-university cooperation including student exchanges. (XNA, JUN 1, 1991)

Colombia (May 27)

Agreement on cultural and education cooperation for 1991-93. Under it, the two countries will boost their exchanges in the sectors of theater, literature, education, television, and science. (XNA, May 28, 1991)

Cuba (May 03)

News information exchange agreement between Xinhua News Agency and Prensa Latina. (XNA, May 3, 1991)

France (May 28)

Nuclear fuel technology transfer agreement between the China Nuclear Energy Industry Corp. and the French company Framatome, involving the design and manufacture of 900,000 kW pressure water reactor nuclear fuel assemblies. The agreement stipulates that Framatome will provide China with the technology and equipment needed to upgrade production at the Yibin Nuclear Fuel Fabrication Factory. Officials from China National Nuclear Corporation say that the technology will enable the factory to supply fuel assemblies to the Guangdong Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station by the end of 1993. The French Framatome Corporation, the parent company of Framatome, had previously reached an agreement with the Guangdong Nuclear Power Joint Venture Company for the construction of the Daya Bay

Nuclear Power Station. The agreement signed today is viewed as a further development of Sino-French co-operation in the field of nuclear energy. (XNA, May 28, 1991)

Gabon (May 20)

Agreement under which China will provide a loan (no details). (XNA, May 20, 1991)

Gambia (May 09)

Agreement under which China will provide a loan (no details). (XNA, May 9, 1991)

Hungary (May 29)

Agreement on encouraging and protection of each other's investment. (XNA, May 29, 1991)

Italy (May 10)

Initial treaty on judicial assistance in civil matters. The treaty concerns mutual assistance, the serving of documents and taking of evidence, recognition and enforcement of the court's decisions and arbitral rulings in foreign-related civil cases between the two countries. (XNA, May 10, 1991)

Italy (May 28)

2nd 10-year agreement on economic cooperation. The cooperation will include the fields of telecommunications, energy sources, transport infrastructure, environmental protection, chemistry, metallurgy and personnel training. (XNA, May 28, 1991)

Italy (May 28)

Agreement between the People's Construction Bank and the Monte dei Paschi di Siena on borrowing 10 million U.S.\$ of commercial loan. The commercial loan from Italy, with a five-year term, will also be used in state key projects involving the textiles, machinery, electronics and raw materials industries. (XNA, May 29, 1991)

Japan (May 28)

Agreement between the People's Construction Bank of China and the Industrial Bank of Japan Ltd., the Norinchukin Bank, the Chiba Bank and the Kinki Bank on borrowing 20 million U.S.\$. The money, provided by the In-

dustrial Bank of Japan Ltd., the Norinchukin Bank, the Chiba Bank and the Kinki Bank, is to be the first tax-free loan from Japanese banks to the People's Construction Bank of China since 1989. With a term of five years, the preferential commercial loan will be invested in key state projects in light industry, the textiles industry, and the machinery, electronics and raw materials industries. Mongolia (May 30)

Airline cooperation minutes between Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) and its Mongolian counterpart. Under the minutes, China will open, beginning from August, two routes, Beijing - Ulan Bator, Huhhot - Ulan Bator, each two flights a week. The signing of the minutes marks the resumption of CAAC's flights to Mongolia after a lapse of 30 years. Mongolia reopened its airline service from Ulan Bator to Beijing in 1986 and now two flights a week. (XNA, May 30, 1991)

Myanmar (ex-Burma) (May 11)

Protocol on the construction of bridges over boundary rivers. The projects, the Wanting-Kyukok and Namhpa (Qingshuihe/Chinshwehaw) bridges, will be built over the boundary rivers along the Sino-Burmese border. (XNA, May 12, 1991)

New Zealand (May 09)

Agreement on establishing a consulate general in Auckland and in Shanghai or Guangzhou. (XNA, May 9, 1991)

Peru (May 07)

Agreement to build a cement plant in the Department of San Martin with Chinese assistance. (XNA, May 7, 1991)

San Marino (May 08)

Agreement to upgrade the official relations at the consular level to diplomatic relations at the ambassadorial level as of 15th July 1991. (XNA, May 8, 1991)

Soviet Union (May 17?)

Agreement on the eastern section of the border between China and USSR. (XNA, May 18, 1991)

Soviet Union (May 19)

Agreements on cooperation to promote bilateral ties between institutions of higher learning. Under the agreements, the two countries decided to continue scientific and technological cooperation between their institutions of higher learning, and to recognize each other's diplomas and academic degrees. (XNA, May 21, 1991)

Turkey (May 09)
Agreement on cooperation in tourism.
(XNA, May 9, 1991)

Turkey (May 27)
Cultural exchange program for 1991-93. Under the program China and Turkey will promote the exchange of visits of scholars, send teachers to work in universities of each other's countries, exchange five scholarships each year as well as promote the cooperation between Xinhua News Agency and Anatolia News Agency.
(XNA, May 27, 1991)

U.S.A. (May 22)
Agreement to extend and amend for five years the agreement on cooperation in science and technology of Jan 1979. The two countries have reached cooperation protocols in 27 areas including agriculture, education, basic science, telecommunication and high-energy physics, and achieved results in many cooperative projects.
(XNA, May 22, 1991)

Venezuela (May 23)
Agreement on cultural cooperation. Under it, universities from the two countries will establish contracts to organize training courses, postgraduate courses, assistantships and professional updating courses. The two countries will exchange documentaries and radio and television musical programs, and broadcast special programs. In 1992, a week-long Chinese movie festival will be held in Venezuela, followed by a Venezuelan film festival in China in 1993. (XNA, May, 23, 1991)

UN World Food Program (May 29?)
The WFP has approved a five-year agricultural assistance project worth 25 million U.S.\$ to Yunnan Province. The money will go to help raise the living standards of more than 200,000 on China's poorest farmers and will be given to local people as food aid to increase production of cereals, raise more animals, halt soil erosion and deforestation, and bring roads and clean drinking water to isolated villages in the province. (XNA, May 29, 1991)

Agreement to build a cement plant in San Martin Department. Under it, China will invest over 5.8 million U.S. dollars in machinery and equipment

and will send technicians to train local personnel for the future plant, designed to turn out 30,000 tons of cement a year. Peru will put some 1.7 million dollars into the project, which will start in the second quarter of next year and finish two years later.

Dismissed from his post as vice-minister of agriculture (XNA, May 15, 1991).

Wang Xueping
Elected vice-governor of Hainan Province (Haikou Radio, May 12, 1991; cit. SWB, May 15, 1991).
Wang is a newcomer.

Wang Yuefeng 王越丰
Resigned from his position as vice-governor of Hainan (Haikou Radio, May 12, 1991; cit. SWB, May 15, 1991).

Wu Jianguo
Identified as deputy editor-in-chief of *Qiushi* (XNA, May 22, 1991).
Wu is a newcomer.

Yan Mingfu 阎明复
Appointed vice-minister for civil affairs (XNA, Jun 1, 1991).
