## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### Australia (Jun 29)

Minutes of the inaugural China-Australia Joint Science and Technology Commission. According to the document the two countries formulated some 20 cooperative research projects in eight fields, including new materials, remote sensing, environment, the combination of Chinese and western medicine and other areas.

Under the program, in 1991-1993 the two governments will exchange the visits of delegations in the fields of press and publication, broadcasting and television, and education and culture. China and Chile also will promote mutual transfer of books and tv programs and university-to-university cooperations including student exchange.

### Japan (Jun 28)

Agreement to float China bonds relating to the 7th issuing of 5-year yen-dominated bonds. The 20 billion yen (145 million US\$) issue is the first bond to be floated by a Chinese bank in western capital markets since April 1989. The Chinese Foreign Exchange Bank has set the coupon on its seventh bonds at 7.7 percent. The bonds are issued at 100.80 against par of 100 for a subscribers' yield of 7.48 percent.

### Netherlands (Jun 14)

Memorandum of understanding on cooperation in geology, under which the two countries will cooperate in research and exchange information in geology, hydrography, engineering geology, environment and energetic geology of the quaternary period and other aspects of mutual interest.

### Poland (Jun 07)

Agreement to adapt the trade and economic cooperation to the new situation after the reforms of foreign trade systems in the two countries. According to it, while the two governments are enhancing the economic and trade relations of state-level foreign trade companies they will actively support and encourage the direct economic and trade cooperation among local foreign trade companies and other economic organizations. Various forms of economic and trade cooperation, such as trade in cash, barter trade, joint ventures and trade representative offices,

will be conducive to the development of bilateral trade and economic cooperation.

Cooperation agreement between XNA and the Romanian Press Agency.

### Soviet Union (Jun 07)

Agreement on cooperation of animal quarantine and veterinary. Under it, the two countries will make joint efforts to prevent animal epidemic diseases from across the border through trade of animal products, animal raw materials and fodder. The two sides will also exchange monthly information on animal epidemic diseases.

### Spain (Jun 07)

Agreement on sports cooperation 1991-92. Under it, in the next two years China and Spain will exchange visits in 17 sports events, including basketball, volleyball, table tennis, swimming and judo.

### Turkey (Jun 18)

Memorandum exchanging data and experience on seismic risk reduction between 1992 and 1993. The memorandum notes that two sides will cooperate on the topics of observation techniques for earthquake precursors, methods of earthquake prediction, earthquake hazard assessment and risk analysis, fault mechanism research, engineering seismology, earthquake counter measure studies and landslide monitoring techniques.

### Ecuador

China agreed to help build a potable water network in Portovelo in the Province of El Oro. Under the program, the potable plant with a production capacity of 4,000 tons a day will raise the water supply capacity from 250 liters to 700 liters per second while the city's water pipe system will also be rebuilt. Under an agreement signed on May 4, 1990, China will not only give Ecuador loans for the project but send technicians there to carry out the project as well.

**Chen Hong**

Appointed vice-minister of civil affairs. (XNA, Jun 1, 1991)  
Chen is a newcomer.

**Chen Kuiyuan 陈奎元**  
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. (Neimenggu Ribao, May 7, 1991; cit. SWB, Jun 27, 1991)  
Chen has been a member of Standing Committee of Inner Mongolia CP since Dec 1989.

**Chen Tiedi (f) 陈铁迪**  
Appointed deputy secretary of Shanghai CP. (XNA, Jun 12, 1991)  
Chen was born in 1935. In 1956 she graduated from Shanghai Tongji University. 1957-66 she served as a lecturer and professor at Nanjing Engineering Institute and Tongji University. 1978-82 she was CCP secretary of Tongji University. In Mar 1983 she was elected member of the Standing Committee of Shanghai CP and in Apr 1988 vice-chairman of Shanghai's People's Congress.

**Chen Zonggao 陈宗皋**  
Removed from his position as deputy director of the Taiwan Affairs Office under the State Council. (XNA, Jun 1, 1991)

**Hu Qili 胡启立**  
Appointed vice-minister of machine building and electronics industry. (XNA, Jun 1, 1991)  
As one of the closest associates of Zhao Ziyang Hu was ousted from the CCP Politburo and Central Committee after the smashing of the students' unrests in Jun 1989 but did not lose his position as deputy for Tianjin to the 7th NPC.

**Jiang Qing (f) 江青**  
Mao Zedong's widow committed suicide on May 14 after having been released from custody on bail for medical treatment ten days before. (XNA, Jun 4, 1991)

**Keyum Bawudun 克尤木巴吾东**  
Identified as vice-chairman of Xinjiang Autonomous Region Government. (XNA, Jun 26, 1991)  
Keyum, a Uighur, served as secretary of the Communist Youth League from 1981 until 1985 when he was elected alternate member of the CCP Central Committee. Since then he has been serving as member of the Standing Committee of Xinjiang CP.

**Liu Ji 刘吉**  
Appointed vice-minister of the State Physical Culture and Sports Commission. (XNA, Jun 1, 1991)

Since Mar 1990 Liu has been Party secretary of the Training Bureau under this commission.

**Liu Pingyuan**

Appointed vice-minister of posts and telecommunications. (XNA, Jun 1, 1991)  
Liu is a newcomer.

**Rui Xingwen 芮杏文**  
Appointed vice-minister of the State Planning Commission. (XNA, Jun 1, 1991)

Rui, a member of the CCP Central Committee since 1985, served as vice-minister of space industry and then of the State Planning Commission from 1982 until 1984 when he became minister of urban and rural construction and environment protection in July 1984. In June 1985 he was made secretary of Shanghai CP, a position he held until Nov 1987 when he became a member of the Secretariat of the CCP Central Committee, a position he held until June 1989.

**Song Zhiyuan 宋直元**  
Relieved from his position as vice-minister of posts and telecommunications. (XNA, Jun 1, 1991)

**Wang Lequan 王乐泉**  
Resigns from his position as vice-governor of Shandong. (Jinan Radio, Jun 22, 1991; cit. SWB, Jun 27, 1991)

**Wu Yi (f) 吴义**  
Appointed vice-minister of foreign economic relations and trade. (XNA, Jun 21, 1991)  
Wu, an alternate member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been vice-mayor of Beijing before.

**Yang Xiliang**  
Appointed vice-minister of radio, film and television. (XNA, Jun 21, 1991)  
Yang is a newcomer.

**Yi Junhua 伊钧华**  
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. (Nei Menggu Ribao, May 7, 1991; cit. SWB, Jun 27, 1991)  
Yi was a newcomer when he could be identified as secretary of Hohhot Municipality CP in June 1989.

**Zhang Defu 张德福**  
The deputy commander of Chengdu Military Region lost his life in an aircraft accident on Jun 16, 1991. (XNA, Jun 28, 1991)

**Zhao Qizheng 赵启正**  
Appointed vice-mayor of Shanghai. (Shanghai Radio, Jun 19, 1991; cit. SWB, Jun 21, 1991)  
Zhao has been member of the Standing Committee of Shanghai CP and director of its Organization Department before.

**Zhu Muzhi 朱穆之**  
Appointed director of the Information Office under the State Council. (XNA, Jun 4, 1991)

A journalist of long standing Zhu had been a member of the 10th and 11th Central Committees and became a member of the Central Advisory Commission under the CCP Central Committee in 1985. In Nov 1987 he served as speaker of the 13th Party Congress. At the age of 75 he now received a new prominent position.
