## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### Czechoslovakia (Mar 11)

Agreement on a plan for implementing scientific cooperation in 1992-93 between the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences and the Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences.

### Hungary (Mar 12)

China suspends some articles contained in the Chinese-Hungarian mutual exemption of visas agreement signed in 1988. Starting from March 17, Hungarian citizens who hold individual passports, and travel and return certificates will only be able to enter the territory of China with valid visas.

### Nepal (Mar 08)

- A Minutes of the 6th Session of the China-Nepal Joint Economic and Trade Committee under which new forms of economic assistance including joint venture projects between enterprises of both countries with support of the two governments shall be opened up;
- B Agreement to expand overland trade and to take measures to improve the border facilities, banking facilities in particular, for import and export trade so as to promote the economic development in their respective border areas;
- C Exchange of letters on the construction of a permanent bridge over the Seti River in Pokhara and

on the expenses incurred on the first technical cooperation for the Lumbini Sugar Mill.

### Sri Lanka (Mar 17)

Loan agreement, under which China will provide 50 million yuan (about 9.56 million U.S.\$) interest-free. The funds will be used to finance projects in Sri Lanka to be agreed upon between the two governments. The terms of the loan are favorable to Sri Lanka since it carries no interest levy and allows for a repayment period of 20 years including an initial grace period of 10 years. China extended a loan of 50 million yuan on similar terms in

1990 to finance a water supply project and construction of the central mail exchange complex in Colombo.

Gao is a newcomer.

**Gao Tingbiao**

Elected vice-governor of Liaoning. (XNA, Mar 13, 1992)

Gao is a newcomer.

**Gao Yan 高严**

Elected governor of Jilin Province. (XNA, Mar 12, 1992)

Gao, who was born in 1942, has been vice-governor of Jilin before.

**Li Shengshen 李根深**

Elected vice-chairman of Heilongjiang People's Congress. (Heilongjiang TV, Mar 8, 1992; cit. SBW, April 2, 1992)

Li, a member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, had been secretary of Harbin Municipality CP from May 1988 until November 1991.

**Li Shenglin 李生林**

Identified as vice-mayor of Tianjin Municipality. (XNA, Mar 1, 1992)

Li has been director of the Institute of Chinese Trade Union Movement before.

**Li Zhenhua 李振华**

Dismissed from his position as vice-governor of Shanxi Province for incompetent leadership. (XNA, Mar 5, 1992)

**Meng Fulin 孟富林**

Elected vice-chairman of Anhui People's Congress. (Hefei Radio, Mar 14, 1992; cit. SWB, Mar 18, 1992)

Meng served as vice-governor of Anhui from 1980 until 1987 and has been deputy secretary of Anhui CP since May 1988.

**Ren Junjie 任俊杰**

Elected vice-chairman of Jilin People's Congress. (XNA, Mar 12, 1992)

Ren has been secretary-general of Jilin CP since Oct 1989.

**Wang Renzhong 王任重**

Deceased Mar 16, 1992. (XNA, Mar 16, 1992)

Wang's last positions: member, CCP 13th Central Committee; vice-chairman, 7th CPPCC. Wang served as director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee from March 1980 until 1982.

**Wang Wenyuan 王文元**

Appointed deputy procurator general of the Supreme People's Procuratorate. (XNA, Mar 16, 1992)

Wang, born 1931 in Hubei Province, has been vice-governor of Liaoning Province before.

Wang has been chairman of the Planning Commission under Shandong People's Government before.
