Agreement for the mutual exemption of visas for travel between the two countries. According to it, the second such agreement between the two countries since 1988, citizens of either country holding diplomatic or business passports, and their spouses and under-age children using the same passport, are exempted of obtaining visas when they enter, exit or transit the other country. The agreement will go into effect from May 28, 1992, when the 1988 agreement becomes invalid. Citizens from either country holding passports from a third country are required to obtain visas before entering, exiting or transiting either of the two countries.

Kenya (Apr 24)

A Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. Under it, the Chinese government will provide Kenya with an interest-free loan of 50 million Chinese yuan (about 9 million US\$) to finance various development projects in the East African country. The loan will be repaid in ten years after a 10-year moratorium.

B Letter of exchange, under which the Chinese government will grant a batch of medical equipment and drugs worth two million Chinese yuan (about 370.000 US\$) to Kenya.

Vietnam (Apr 13 ?)

Agreement on cooperation in several areas of banking. State bankers of the two sides will exchange information, visits, studies and will open representative offices. They also agreed on modalities on payment in trade.

Yemen (Apr 20)

Exchange of notes affirming that the consular treaty between the People's Republic of China and the Yemen Arab Republic is now applicable to the Republic of Yemen.

INTELSAT (Apr 24)

Contract between China's Great Wall Industry Corporation and the International Telecommunication Satellite Organization or INTELSAT to use China's "Long March" rocket to launch a satellite or spacecraft in 1995-96. The about 60-million-\$ contract calls for the first commercial launch of "Long March" 2c/Ho series rocket to carry either an INTELSAT VII-A satellite, or one of the next series of INTELSAT Spacecraft. The launch is scheduled tentatively between December 1, 1995 and February 29, 1996. INTELSAT has 122 member countries and China is one of them. The organization offers global communications services, such as international video, teleconferencing, facsimile, data and telex for 180 member and non-member countries through its 17-satellite global system.

UNIDO (Apr 20)

Agreement on the second phase of the UN Industrial Development Organization Beijing Center of industrial cooperation for 1992 and 1993.

UN World Food Program (Apr 03)

Agreement on the WFP to provide a grant of 14 million US\$ to the Southwest China province of Yunnan. The agreement focuses on food production and poverty alleviation, targeting ethnic-minority areas in Yunnan. The project will rehabilitate and construct irrigation systems and introduce land improvement measures so as to increase food production and protect the environment. Over 200,000 farmers are expected to benefit from the "food-for-work" program, under which farmers receive food in exchange for work.

Activities to be implemented include land levelling, terracing, conversion of dry land into paddy land, deep ploughing and interplanting, reconstruction of major canals, apple-tree planting, pasture development, road construction and village sanitation. The WFP is currently assisting 11 development projects in China, valued at 163 million US\$ in total. The projects concentrate on food production in poor and remote areas.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Kenya

A modern sports complex built with Chinese assistance was handed over in April 1992. The sports complex, known as the Moi International Sports Center, is located at the northern suburb of the capital city of Nairobi. It is composed of a 60,000-seat stadium, a 5,000-seat gymnasium, a 2,000-seat aquatic stadium and 200-bed athletes quarters.

Removed as vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. (Neimenggu Ribao, Mar 1, 1992; cit. SWB, May 1, 1992)

Removed as vice-governor of Jiangsu. (Hongkong TKP, Apr 24, 1992; cit. SWB, May 2, 1992)

Deng Hongxun 邓鸿勋

Elected chairman, People's Congress of Hainan Province. (XNA, Apr 30, 1992)

Deng, an alternate member of the CCP 13th Central Committee, has been secretary of Hainan Province CP since July 1990.

Guo Tingbiao 郭廷彪

Elected vice-governor of Liaoning Province. (in C.a. 92/03 mistakenly named Gao Tingbicco)

Guo was born in 1941 and belongs to the Hui minority. He was elected deputy for Liaoning to the 7th NPC (in March 1988 when he served as mayor of Liaoyang City. In Feb 1991 he was made mayor of Dandong City.

Kang Keqing (f) 康克清

Deceased Apr 22, 1992 at the age of 81. (XNA, Apr 27, 1992)
Kang, the widow of marshal Zhu De, became a member of the CCP in 1931 and took part in the Long March, Oct 1934 - Oct 1936. She was a member of the CCP 11th and 12th Central Committee and chairwoman of the Women's Federation from 1978 until 1988, when she was made the federation's honorary chairwoman.

Lei Yu 雷宇

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Government of Guangxi Autonomous Region. (XNA, Apr 27, 1992)

Dismissed of his post as deputy Party secretary of Hainan District for misuse of public funds in Aug 1985 and rehabilitated in Jan 1988, when he was made vice-mayor of Guangzhou received an elevation with his new position.

Ling Qihong

Relieved as vice-governor of Jiangsu Province. (Hongkong TKP, Apr 24, 1992; cit. SWB, May 2, 1992)

Ma Shiqing 马世清

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Qinghai Province. (XNA, Apr 30, 1992)

Ma belongs to the Hui minority and is a newcomer.

Song Zhimin 宋志民

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Government of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. (XNA, Apr 30, 1992)

Song is a newcomer.

You Dexin 游德馨

Relieved at his own request from his position as vice-governor of Fujian Province. (Hongkong TKP, Apr 29, 1992; cit. SWB, May 2, 1992)

Yu Xinglong 于兴隆

Elected vice-chairman of the People's Congress of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. (XNA, Apr 30, 1992)

Yu belongs to the Mongol minority. He bis a newcomer.

Yun Bulong 云布龙
Elected vice-chairman of the People's Government of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region. (XNA, Apr 30, 1992)

Yun belongs to the Mongol minority. He is a newcomer.
