## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### Bulgaria (Jun 27)

Agreement on scientific and cultural cooperation during 1992-94. (BTA, Jun. 27, 1992; cit. SWB, Jun 30, 1992)

### Egypt (Jun 29)

Minutes of the 1st session of the Sino-Egyptian Joint Committee on Economy and Trade. (XNA, Jun 29, 1992)

### Georgia (Jun 09)

Communiqué on the establishment of diplomatic relation at ambassadorial level. (XNA, Jun 9, 1992)

### Greece (Jun 25)

A Agreement on encouraging and mutually protecting investment;  
B Agreement on economic, industrial and technological cooperation. (XNA, Jun 25, 1992)

### Italy (Jun 09)

Agreement for the construction of a cultural relics protection and restoration center in northwest China's Shaanxi province. The center will be jointly set up by Shaanxi province and the Italian government which donated 4.7 billion Italian liras (about 3.8 million US\$) to the project. The center will provide services related to the protection and restoration of cultural relics and will help train professionals in the sector. The center will also provide technical assistance to other northwestern provinces and autonomous regions. (XNA, Jun 9, 1992)

### Laos (Jun 03)

Protocol on China to provide assistance to Laos in building a road between Luang Namtha and Bokeo provinces and in constructing small hydroelectric dams. (Lao Radio, Jun 3, 1992; cit. SWB, Jun 6, 1992)

### Morocco (Jun 30)

A Agreement on economic and technological cooperation. Under it, China will provide Morocco with an interest-free loan of 30 million yuan (about 5.5 million US\$).  
B Exchange of notes on aid from the Chinese government in the form of materials worth of three million yuan (about 550,000 US\$). (XNA, Jun 30, 1992)

### Myanmar (Jun 12)

Document of the "United Nations International Drug Control Program Project of the Governments of China and Myanmar". The three-year project with the financial assistance of 7.6 million US\$ from the United Nations Drug Control Program (UNDCP) is aimed at reducing opium cultivation and heroin trafficking along the common border areas of Myanmar and China. The Chinese delegation, together with delegations from the UNDCP, Thailand and Laos, made a study tour of north and south border areas of Myanmar's Shan State which neighbors with Thailand and Laos, constituting a "golden triangle area", one of the major narcotic drugs producing bases in the world. ### Russia (Jun 19)

Treaty on providing judicial assistance in civil and criminal cases. (XNA, Jun 19, 1992)

### Thailand (Jun 04)

Letters on aid from China to Thailand for the royal development projects in northern Thailand. The one million U.S. dollar aid, that the Chinese

government will render gratis, includes manual tools, saplings, seeds, personnel training and sending experts for guidance to the royal development projects.
