AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Armenia (Jul 04)

- A Protocol on consultation between the two foreign ministries;
 - B Agreement on scientific and technological cooperation;
 - C Agreement on encouraging and mutually protecting investment;
 - D Agreement on cultural, educational, public health, sports and tourism cooperation;

Belorussia (Jul 10)

Agreement on health cooperation. Under it, the Chinese government will provide Chinese traditional medicine and medical equipment to Belorussia and it will also send Chinese medical teams to work there in six months.

Czechoslovakia (Jul 21)

Agreement on customs cooperation. Under it, the two sides will trade experiences on customs affair, exchange laws on customs and provide each other administrative assistance.

India (Jul 01)

Protocol on entry and exit procedures for border trade. The protocol stipu-

lates that the market sites designated at Gunji of India's northern state of Uttar Pradesh and Pulan of China's Tibetan Autonomous Region will be opened up for border trade between June and September every year. The protocol is in line with the memorandum on the resumption of bilateral border trade signed between the two sides during Chinese premier Li Peng's visit to India last December.

Ivory Coast (Jul 10)

- A Agreement on China to provide interest-free loans. Under the agreement, the loans will be used in cooperative projects in the economic, technological and cultural fields.

Revised agreement for exemption of visas for business travel. According to the revised agreement, which will come into effect from July 27, citizens of each country holding diplomatic or service passports, seaman books or crewman licenses, are exempted from visas when they enter either country for official business. However, visas

will be required of citizens holding ordinary passports for public affairs.

The 240-kilometer highway runs between Phnom Penh and Kompong Som leading to Sihanouk Harbor in southwestern Cambodia. It boasts 24 bridges, six of which had been severely damaged. Repairing the Kompong Cham airport will be the next task for the Chinese.
