Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. Under it, China will provide Pakistan with an interest-free loan of 50 million renminbi (about 10 million US\$) in the next five years for projects to be decided through mutual consultations. China will provide relief goods worth three million renminbi (about 600,000 US\$) to the Afghan refugees in Pakistan.

Switzerland (Oct 19)

Agreement between the Chinese Ministry of Chemical Industry and a Swiss company on long-term cooperation in research, environmental protection, production management and training of chemical industry personnel. Under it, China and the Swiss enterprise, Ciba-Geigy Ltd., will cooperate in such fields as dyestuffs, pigments and plas-

tics through joint research, technical exchanges and transfers, and establishment of joint ventures. To ensure such long-term cooperation, the two sides are ready to form a coordinating group. (XNA, Oct 19, 1991)

Tunisia (Oct 31)

Executive program for cultural cooperation. (XNA, Oct 31, 1991)

U.S.A. (Oct 24)

Memorandum on consultation regarding shipping and related matters of concern. Under the terms of the memorandum, China will now permit U.S. carriers to establish entities in China. These could be either in the form of joint ventures or wholly-owned subsidiaries (sole ventures) and would be subject to the relevant Chinese laws on joint and sole ventures. This would apply for ships owned or operated by U.S. carriers or for cargo moving under the U.S. carriers' bill of lading or tariff. The memorandum also included measures to solve specific issues facing the concerned carriers of both countries. (XNA, Oct 25, 1991)

Venezuela (Oct 22)

A Agreement on cooperation in agriculture, animal husbandry and fisheries;
B Supplementary agreement for cooperation agreement on oil exploration and development.

Antarctic Treaty (Oct 04)

Protocol on Antarctic environmental protection under which any mining activities of mineral resources will be prohibited in the coming 50 years except those for purposes of scientific research. (XNA, Oct 4, 1991)

Asian Development Bank (Oct 18)

Three cooperative agreements:
A Financial and technical assistance agreement, according to which ADB provides a loan of 100 million

US\$ to the Industrial and Commercial Bank of China for technical transformation in China's enterprises;

- B Xiamen International Bank capital subscription agreement, according to which ADB, the Long-Term Credit Bank of Japan, and the Sino Finance Group Limited of the United States are to take a 25 percent interest as new shareholders in the Xiamen International Bank. As a result, the Bank's paid-up capital will be increased from 420 million HK\$ to 620 million HK\$. This is the first time for ADB to become a shareholder in a Chinese Bank;
- C Joint-financing agreement, according to which some international financial institutions will supply loans totalling 48 million US\$ to the ADB for construction of Nanpu bridge in Shanghai, one of the city's key projects.

Asian Development Bank (Oct 21)

Technical assistance grant of 600,000 US\$ to China for improving statistical services. The objective of the grant is to strengthen the State Statistical Bureau in its capability in improving national accounts statistics in the country. The grant will be financed from the bank's technical assistance special fund. (XNA, Oct 4, 1991)
