## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### Bangladesh (Aug 29)

- A Protocol on the 7th meeting of the Joint Economic and Trade Committee;
  - B Agreement on economic and technological cooperation;
  - C Protocol on an interest-free Chinese loan of 30 million yuan to help establish Sino-Bangladesh joint ventures in Bangladesh. The loan, equivalent to roughly 5.45 million US\$, will be used mainly to support Bangladesh enterprises intending and capable of establishing medium and small joint ventures with Chinese businesses. The loan represents a new formula China adopted this year to develop cooperation with other developing nations.

### Myanmar (Aug 12)

- A Exchange of letters on economic and technical cooperation projects. Under them China agrees to supply the equipment and relevant accessories, and dispatch experts to supervise the installation for the two satellite communication earth stations.
  - B Exchange of letters on China to supply the spare parts and dispatch experts to supervise the maintenance for the Mawlamyine steam power station. The two projects shall be paid out of the loan stipulated under the agreement on economic and technical cooperation signed on August 23, 1991 between the Myanmar and Chinese governments.

### North Korea (Aug 18)

Protocol of the 32nd Conference on Scientific and Technical Exchange and Cooperation. It contains 48 projects of which 25 will come under China's responsibility and the other 23 go to North Korea with two more projects for joint research.

- A Protocol determining the state of and prospects for bilateral trade, economic, scientific and technical relations, including cross border and inter-regional trade;

- C Principled accords on the development of cooperation in all fields, including the establishment of mixed state-run and commercial businesses with a view to reaching out to the markets of third countries;

- A Agreement on economic and technological cooperation. Under it, China is to provide Tanzania with a five-year interest-free loan of 50 million yuan (about 9.1 million US\$).
  - B Exchange of notes under which China will give a batch of general materials worth of two million yuan (about 360,000 US\$) to the Tanzanian government.
  - C Executive program for cultural cooperation 1992-94.

### World Food Program (Aug 20)

Agreement approving over 12 million US\$ in WFP food assistance to Shanxi Province. According to the project, which is titled "soil and water conservation works in Luliang Prefecture in Shanxi Province", will in the coming five years supply 78,830 tons of wheat in a grant, equivalent to about 12,238,360 US\$, to three project counties in the Luliang area. During the same period, the counterpart funds from the Chinese government will equal 10,108,100 US\$. The WFP assistance will be used mainly as an incentive to support the labor-intensive activities, including land terracing, rehabilitation and development of the irrigation network, construction of dams, embankments and roads, functional literacy and basic technical training. It is expected that over 244,000 farmers of 66,000 households in the area will benefit from the project.

## CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

### Bangladesh

A China-assisted 210 megawatt thermal power station is under construction at the South District of Chittagong. The project will be completed in April 1993. The Chinese government provides Bangladesh with 2,770 million taka (about 70 million US\$) for the project. (XNA, Aug 1, 1992)

### Sri Lanka

Construction of the third water project with China's aid commenced at Chilaw in northwestern Sri Lanka. The project, which is expected to go into operation in August 1994, will provide 7,200 metric tons of clean water for the 39,000 residents at the low-lying Chilaw town 75 kilometers north of Colombo. The first water project with China's aid, located in Polonnaruwa, eastern Sri Lanka, went into operation in 1990. The second water project is under construction at Puttalam in northcentral province. ### He Dongchang 何东昌

Recalled as vice-minister of the State Education Commission. (XNA, Aug 21, 1992)

### Li Chunting 李春亭

Identified as deputy secretary of Shandong Province CP. (XNA, Aug 25, 1992)

Born in 1936 in Shandong, Li started to serve as a Party cadre in a county of his home province in 1966. He became vice-governor of Shandong in Feb 1988.

### Li Lanqing 李岚清

Appointed concurrently director of the Economic and Trade Office under the State Council. (XNA, Aug 21, 1992)

Li, an alternate member of the CCP Central Committee, has been minister of foreign economic relations and trade since Dec 1990.

### Liu Zepeng 刘泽彭

Appointed deputy director of the Overseas Chinese Affairs Office under the State Council. (XNA, Aug 21, 1992)

The 1946 born Liu had been deputy director of the Organization Department under the CCP Central Committee before.

### Wang Liping 王力平

Appointed deputy secretary of Shanghai CP. (Shanghai Radio, Aug 29, 1992; cit. SWB, Aug 31, 1992)

Wang was a newcomer when he was elected member of the Standing Committee of Shanghai CP in Oct 1986.

### Wang Senhao 王森浩

Removed from his position as governor of Shanxi and appointed chairman of the China National Corporation for Coal Mines. (XNA, Aug 21, 1992)

Wang has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since Sep 1985. He not only graduated from a mining institute but also wrote books on coal dust in mines and on enterprise management. So he is a real expert in his new position.

### Wang Wenze 王文泽

Appointed president of the State Energy Investment Corporation. (XNA, Aug 21, 1992)

Wang has been director of the General Office under the Ministry of Energy Resources before.

### Xia Keqiang

Appointed vice-mayor of Shanghai. (XNA, Aug 29, 1992)

Xia was born in 1940 and graduated from the East China Institute of Chemical Technology. Since 1983 he served in Shanghai Government, being in charge of construction projects, such as the Nanpu bridge and the Shanghai subway.

### Xu Guangdi

Appointed vice-mayor of Shanghai. (XNA, Aug 29, 1992)

Xu was born in 1938 and graduated in 1959 from the Beijing Institute of Iron and Steel Engineering. Since 1986 he was serving as vice-president of Shanghai Polytechnical University.
