During the same period, the counterpart funds from the Chinese government will equal 10,108,100 US\$. Die WFP assistance will be used mainly as an incentive to support the labor-intensive activities, including land terracing, rehabilitation and development of the irrigation network, construction of dams, embankments and roads, functional literacy and basic technical training. It is expected that over 244,000 farmers of 66,000 households in the area will benefit from the project.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Bangladesh

A China-assisted 210 megawatt thermal power station is under construction at the South District of Chittagong. The project will be completed in April 1993. The Chinese government provides Bangladesh with 2,770 million taka (about 70 million US\$) for the project. (XNA, Aug 1, 1992)

Sri Lanka

Construction of the third water project with China's aid commenced at Chilaw in northwestern Sri Lanka. The project, which is expected to go into operation in August 1994, will provide 7,200 metric tons of clean water for the 39,000 residents at the low-lying Chilaw town 75 kilometers north of Colombo. The first water project with China's aid, located in Polonnaruwa, eastern Sri Lanka, went into operation in 1990. The second water project is under construction at Puttalam in northcentral province.
