## AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

### Afghanistan (Nov 07)

Cooperation protocol between the Ministry of Water and Electric Power of Afghanistan and the Ministry of Water Resources of China. According to this protocol work will begin in the near future on the revival of the irrigation complex of Parwan Province. Furthermore, cooperation will be extended in the field of new small hydro-electric power stations and the Baghdara project.

### Cuba (Nov 21)

Protocol on scientific and technological cooperation 1991-93. According to it, China and Cuba will send experts in 35 fields to each others' country over the next few years. China will send experts in agriculture, fisheries and biotechnology to impart relevant technical knowledge to their Cuban counterparts. China will also send specialized people to Cuba to study Cuba's sugarcane growing technology and the technology to produce sugarcane products. Cuba will send 20 expert groups to China to study science and technology related problems.

Agreement for a program of exchange of Chinese and Japanese technological personnel. China will select young technicians to go to Japan to study in enterprises, and retired Japanese technicians will act as consultants in China.

The original agreement, signed June 16, 1987, restricted the exemption to citizens holding diplomatic passports.

### World Bank (Nov 08)

The World Bank approved a loan of 162 million US\$ to China for an agricultural development project in Guangdong Province. The loan is repayable in 35 years, including a 10-years grace period.

The agricultural project aims to increase fish populations at 100-250 meter depths in the South China Sea. This will relieve pressure on near-coastal

banks, develop coastal mud flats and low-lying land for aquaculture, increase production of fruit on sloping land, bring new land into agricultural production, and improve river-flow conditions in the Pearl River delta.

The project would include the following: provision of 86 fishing vessels, construction of about 4,000 ha of ponds and 11,000 cages for aquaculture, improvement of 10,700 ha and establishment of 3,300 ha of orchards on uncultivated hilly lands, land reclamation works for improvement and expansion of 6,500 ha of sugarcane, and establishment of agro-processing facilities to utilize locally available raw materials.
