Protocol on scientific and technological cooperation 1991-92. It includes the study of sand and silt movements along harbors, study of advanced technology for the rural areas, of crops, processing of jute, and technical services and population control.

It stipulates that the two parties shall cooperate in the peaceful applications of space sciences and technology, such as satellite technology and satellite launching service, on the basis of the principles of friendly cooperation, equality and mutual benefit.

B Agreement for cooperation in scientific and technological fields. Under it, the two sides will conduct joint research and exchange study visits, information, documents and data in various scientific and technological fields.

The loans are for a 140,000-ton ethylene project in Tianjin to import equipment and technology from Spain.
