AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Iran (Sep 10)

Agreement on cooperation in the peaceful use of nuclear energy. (XNA, Sep 10, 1992)

Jordan (Sep 29)

Protocol on economic and technology cooperation, under which China will provide 50 million yuan in interest-free loans to support joint economic cooperation programs. (XNA, Sep 29, 1992)

Micronesia (Sep 19)

A Agreement on cultural cooperation under which the two countries will exchange personnel, books and other items of interest;

B Accounting procedures for an economic and technological cooperation agreement negotiated in 1990, under which the Chinese government is providing 10 million yuan in loans (about 1.8 million US\$) to Micronesia between 1991 and 1995 to fund cooperative projects between the two countries;

C Inspection procedures on a multi-functional convention center to be built in Micronesia, and the gift to Micronesia of six Chinese-made jeeps worth 1.5 million yuan (about 0.27 million US\$). (XNA, Sep 19, 1992)

Namibia (Sep 07)

Agreement on economic and technological cooperation. (XNA, Sep 7, 1992)

Nepal (Sep 09)

Exchange of letters on China's grant assistance to construct a cancer hospital. The proposed hospital, to be build

in Bharatpur of Chitwan District, southern Nepal, will have 100 beds and a floor space of 9,000 square meters, including the quarters for doctors and nurses. China will also provide general medical apparatus to the hospital. (XNA, Sep 9, 1992)

Netherlands (Sep 23)

Agreement on cooperation in agricultural research. Under it, both sides are to stimulate effective cooperation through the exchange of information, materials, scientists, experts and trainees. (XNA, Sep 23, 1992)

Russia (Sep 11)

Copyright trade cooperation protocol. According to it, the two sides will adopt active measures to protect the lawful interests and copyrights of the other side's authors. (XNA, Sep 11, 1992)

Singapore (Sep 17)

Interfactor agreement between the Bank of China and DBS Factors PTE Ltd., a subsidiary of the Development Bank of Singapore. (XNA, Sep 17, 1992)

South Korea (Sep 30)

A Trade agreement;
B Agreement on investment guarantee;
C Agreement on scientific and technological cooperation;
D Agreement to set up regular ministerial committees on economy, trade and technology. (Yonhap, Sep 30, 1992; cit. SWB, Oct 1, 1992)

Turkey (Sep 28)

Agreement on mutual assistance in civil and criminal cases. (XNA, Sep 28, 1992)

Vanuatu (Sep 25)

Agreement on economic and technical cooperation. Under it, China will provide Vanuatu with an interest-free loan

of 20 million renminbi yuan (3.7 million US\$) during the next five years. The agreement also details further cooperation in various fields of economy and technology between the two countries.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Bangladesh

China and Bangladesh discussed in detail the ways and means of completing the 210-megawatt power station being constructed with Chinese assistance at a cost of 5,250 million taka (131.25 million US\$) at Rauzan in the southern port city of Chittagong.

Nepal

China and Nepal signed documents of the engineering designs of a cancer hospital to be built with China's grant assistance. The 100-bed hospital, covering 9,000 square meters, is to be built at Yagyapuri in Bharatpur of Chitwan District, southern Nepal, and would be completed within the next three years.

Zambia

Under a protocol of Sep 16, China will dispatch a new medical team to Zambia. The eighth Chinese medical team, consisting of 25 doctors, will arrive in Zambia in November to replace the seventh team.

Han Zhubin 韩杼滨
Appointed minister of railways. (XNA, Sep 4, 1992)

Han was born in 1932. He worked in railway administration bureaux for a long time. In Dec 1992 he was made director of the Political Department of the Ministry of Railways.

Hu Fuguo 胡富国
Appointed acting governor of Shanxi Province. (XNA, Aug 22, 1992)

Hu was born in 1938 and worked in the coal industry of his home province for a long time. In 1982 he was made vice-minister of coal industry and in 1988 vice-minister of energy resources.

Li Changxing 李长兴
Removed as vice-mayor of Tianjin. (Tianjin RB, Sep 10, 1992; cit. SWB, Sep 26, 1992)

Li Jianguo 李建国
Identified as deputy secretary of Tianjin CP. (Tianjin Radio, Aug 31, 1992; cit. SWB, Sep 26, 1992).

Li has been secretary-general of Tianjin CP before.

Liu Zhongli 刘仲藜
Appointed minister of finance. (XNA, Sep 4, 1992)

Liu was born in 1934 in Ningbo City, Zhejiang Province. Upon graduation from high school he went to Heilongjiang, where he served as vice-chairman of the Planning Commission from 1979-84. In 1985 he became vice-governor of Heilongjiang and in March 1988 vice-minister of finance, a position he held until Aug 1990, when he was made deputy secretary-general of the State Council.

Wan Xueyuan 万学远
Appointed vice-governor of Zhejiang Province. (XNA, Sep 29, 1992)

Wan was born in 1941. His last position has been secretary-general of Shanghai Government.

Wang Xiuzhi 王秀智
Appointed vice-governor of Anhui Province. (Anhui RB, Sep 1, 1992; cit. SWB, Sep 26, 1992)

Wang is a newcomer.

Xie Anshan 谢安山
Appointed vice-president of the Supreme People's Court. (XNA, Sep 4, 1992)

Xie has been president of Jilin Province Higher People's Court before.

Ye Disheng 叶迪生
Appointed vice-mayor of Tianjin. (XNA, Sep 21, 1992)

Ye was born in 1938 and became a semi-conductor specialist. In 1988 he was made general manager of the Corporation of Tianjin's Economic and Technological Development Area and vice-chairman of the Federation of Industry and Commerce.

Zhang Haosheng 张好生
Appointed vice-mayor of Tianjin. (Tianjin Ribao, Sep 10, 1992; cit. SWB, Sep 26, 1992)

Zhang has been secretary of the Party Committee of Tianjin's Heping District before.
