AGREEMENTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES

Cyprus (Oct 22)

Protocol to promote and diversify trade and economic cooperation. (XNA, Oct 22, 1992)

Israel (Oct 30)

Trade agreement, granting each other Most-Favored-Nation trading status. (XNA, Oct 30, 1992)

Japan (Oct 06)

Notes on a Japanese loan of 137.7 billion yen to China. The loan is part of a third to be advanced and will be used on 21 projects including the Ezhou thermal-power plant in central China's Hubei Province and the Wuqiangxi hydro-power plant. (XNA, Oct 6, 1992)

Kuwait (Oct 30)

Kuwait signed an agreement with China to extend a loan of 5.3 million Kuwait dinars (18 million US\$) to help finance the extension project of Xiamen airport in Fujian Province. The new loan, the 16th Sino-Kuwaiti co-operation project since 1982, brings the gulf country's total loan commitment to China to 440 million US\$. (XNA, Oct 31, 1992)

Plan for scientific cooperation 1993-94 between the academies of sciences. (XNA, Oct 31, 1992)

Pakistan (Oct 07)

A Agreement on the establishment of friendly city relations between Beijing and Islamabad;

Russia and Mongolia (Oct 25)

China, Russia and Mongolia agreed to start the work on measuring and determining the two intersection points along the eastern and western sections of the borders from 1993. (XNA, Oct 25, 1992)

Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan (Oct 24)

China held negotiations on the border issue with Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan. The two sides agreed to continue working towards a settlement of the remaining border issue through negotiations. Also, they decided to begin drafting corresponding border treaties and hold continued talks on the border sections not agreed upon early next year. (XNA, Oct 24, 1992)

Removed as vice-minister of forestry. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)

Liu Zhifeng 刘志峰
Appointed vice-minister of the State Economic Restructuring Commission. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)
Liu is a newcomer.

Liu Zhongde 刘忠德
Appointed vice-minister of culture. (TKP, Oct 6, 1992; cit. SWB, Oct 8, 1992)
Liu was born in 1933 in Jilin Province and graduated from Harbin Polytechnical University. Later he served in the

Harbin Civil Engineering Institute and in Nanjing Engineering Institute. In 1985 he was made vice-minister of the State Education Commission and three years later deputy secretary-general of the State Council. In Dec 1990 he became deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee.

Lu Jiang 陆江
Appointed vice-minister of materials and equipment. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)
Lu is a newcomer.

Lu Xusheng 陆叙生
Removed as vice-minister of materials. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)

Wang Zhibao 王志宝
Appointed vice-minister of forestry. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)
Wang is a newcomer.

Xu Kunyuan 许坤元
Appointed vice-minister of textile industry. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)
Xu has been director of the ministry's Planning Department before.

Xu Penghang 徐鹏航
Appointed director of the State Bureau of Technology Supervision. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)

Xu was born in 1940 in Hubei Province. After having served as vice-governor of his home province since Jan 1986 he was made deputy director of the Economic and Trade Office under the State Council, a position he is holding concurrently.

Appointed deputy director of the Economic and Trade Office under the State Council. (XNA, Oct 7, 1992)
Yu has been assistant minister of foreign economic relations and trade before.

Zhang Taiheng 张太恒
Identified as commander of Jinan Military Region. (Shandong Broadcasting Station, Oct 23, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 5, 1992)
Lieutenant-general Zhang served as commander of Chengdu Military Region from May 1990 until fall of 1991. Since spring of 1992 he then has been deputy commander of Nanjing Military Region.

Zheng Bijian 郑必坚
Identified as deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee. (TKP, Oct 7, 1992; cit. SWB, Oct 8, 1992)

Zheng was born in 1932 in Sichuan Province and studied at the Chinese People's University. From 1955 until 1966 he served as a cadre in the Propaganda Department of the CCP Central Committee. In 1987 he was made deputy director of the State International Studies Center. This position he held until Oct 1988 when he was made vice-president of the Academy of Social Sciences. The 14th CCP Congress elected him on Oct 1992 a member of its Central Committee.

Zheng Liangyu 郑良玉
Appointed vice-governor of Jiangxi Province. (XNA, Oct 31, 1992)
The 1934 born Zheng has been mayor of Shenzhen City before.
