Cao Gangchuan 曹刚川

Identified as deputy chief of the PLA General Staff. (XNA, Nov 21, 1992)
Cao has been director of the Military Affairs Department under the PLA General Staff before.

Cao Shuangming 曹双明

Identified as commander of the PLA Air Force. (XNA, Nov 17, 1992)
Cao was born in 1929 in Henan Province. He joined the CCP and PLA in 1946. In 1949 he served in the 2nd Field Army. Three years later he graduated from the Air Force Aviation School. Until 1985 he rose in the Air Force to commander of the Air Force under Shenyang Military Region and became a lieutenant-general in Sep 1988. The CCP Central Committee elected him a member in Oct 1992.

Chen Kuiyuan 陈奎元

Appointed secretary of Tibet Autonomous Region CP. (XNA, Dec 1, 1992)
Chen was born in 1940 in Liaoning Province. He graduated from the Political Education Department of Inner Mongolia Normal College in 1964. Later he served as a teacher in a local Party school and as a Party cadre at town and prefectural levels in Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region (IMAR). In 1989 he was elected a member of IMAR CP and two years later vice-chairman of IMAR People's Congress. In March 1992, he was made deputy secretary of Tibet CP and in Oct 1992 a member of the CCP 14th Central Committee.

Ding Wenchang 丁文昌

Identified as political commissar of the PLA Air Force. (XNA, Nov 18, 1992)
Ding was born in 1933 in Anhui Province. 1951-54 he studied at infantry and air force schools. Until 1988 he rose in the Air Force to director of the Political Department of the Air Force and was appointed major-general in Sep that year. In Oct 1992 he was elected member of the CCP 14th Central Committee.

Fu Quanyou 傅全有

Appointed director of the PLA General Logistics Department. (Hongkong Wen Wei Po, Nov 3, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 4, 1992)

Fu was born in 1930 in Shanxi Province. He joined the PLA in 1946 and the CCP the following year. In 1951 he served in the Northeast Field Army. Until 1985 he then rose to commander of an army. In 1985 he was made commander of Chengdu Military Re-

gion to change as commander of Lanzhou Military Region in 1990. He has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since Sep 1985 and a lieutenant-general since Sep 1988.

Li Jing 李景

Identified as deputy chief of the PLA General Staff. (XNA, Nov 18, 1992)
Li was born in 1930 in Shandong Province. He joined the PLA in 1946 and the CCP three years later. In 1952 he graduated from the aviation school of the PLA Navy and until 1983 rose to deputy commander of the Navy. In July 1985 he was made commander of the Navy Air Force and appointed vice-admiral in Sep 1988. In Oct 1992 the CCP 14th Congress elected him a member of its Central Committee.

Li Xilin 李希林

Identified as commander of Guangzhou Military Region. (Hongkong Ming Pao, Oct 26, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 19, 1992)

Li was born in 1930 in Hebei Province. He joined the PLA in 1945. From 1960 until 1983 he rose from commander of a regiment to chief of staff of an army corps. In 1985 he was made chief of staff of Guangzhou Military Region and in May 1990 its deputy commander. He has been a lieutenant-general since Sep 1988 and a member of the CCP 14th Central Committee since Oct 1992.

Shao Huaze 邵华泽

Identified as director of Renmin Ribao. (Hongkong TKP, Dec 1, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 2, 1992)

Shao has been editor-in-chief of RMRB since June 1989 after having been director of the Propaganda Department of the PLA before. In Oct 1992 the CCP 14th Congress elected him a member of its Central Committee.

Xiao Yang 肖秧

Identified as deputy secretary of Sichuan Province CP and appointed vice-governor Sichuan. (XNA, Nov 29, 1992)

Xiao was born in 1929 in Sichuan Province. In 1953 he graduated from Qinghua University and finished a postgraduate course at a Silicate Research Institute of the German Democratic Republic in 1956. Successively he worked as director of Beijing Glass Plant. In 1983 he was made vice-mayor of Chongqing and two years later its mayor. The CCP 14th Congress elected him an alternate member in Oct 1992.

Yang Zhihai 杨志海

Appointed vice-governor of Heilongjiang Province. (Heilongjiang Ribao, Oct 27, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 10, 1992)
Yang is a newcomer.

Yu Yongbo 于永波

Appointed director of the PLA General Political Department. (Hongkong Wen Wei Po, Nov 3, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 4, 1992)

Yu belongs to the Manzhou minority and was born in 1931 in Liaoning Province. In 1948 he joined the CCP and the 4th Field Army the following year. 1950-54 he served with the "Chinese People's Volunteers" in Korea. From 1963 until 1983 he rose from regiment to army political commissar. In July 1985 he was made director of the Political Department of Nanjing Military Region and a lieutenant-general in Sep 1988. Since Nov 1987 he has been a member of the CCP Central Committee.

Zhang Wannian 张万年

Appointed chief of PLA General Staff. (XNA, Nov 3, 1992)

Zhang was born in 1928 in Shandong Province. In 1944 he joined the 8th Route Army and the CCP the following year. 1947-50 he served in the Northeast Democratic United Army and successively in the Northeast Field Army. From 1961 until 1982 he rose from regiment to army commander. In 1982 he was made deputy commander of Wuhan Military Region and deputy commander of Guangzhou Military Region three years later. In Nov 1988 he became commander of Guangzhou Military Region and commander of Jinan Military Region in May 1990. He was an alternate member of the 12th and 13th CCP Central Committees to be elevated to member by the 14th Party Congress in Oct 1992.

Zhang Zhiqing

Identified as commander of Hainan Military District. (Hainan Broadcasting Station, Nov 1, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 16, 1992)

Zhang is a newcomer.

Zhao Nanqi 赵南起

Identified as commander of the PLA Military Science Academy. (Hongkong Kuai Pao, Nov 18, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 24, 1992)

Zhao has been director of the PLA General Logistic Department before and has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since Sep 1982.

Zhu Dunfa 朱敦法

Identified as commander of the National Defense University. (Hongkong Kuai Pao, Nov 18, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 24, 1992)

Zhu was born in 1927 in Jiangsu Province. He derived from the 2nd Field Army. 1952-55 he served as a regiment commander with the "Chinese People's Volunteers" in Korea. He graduated from the PLA Military Academy in 1960 and until 1984 rose from deputy division to army commander. In Feb 1987 he was made deputy commander of Shenyang Military Region and commander of Guangzhou Military Region in May 1990. He has been a lieutenant-general since Sep 1988 and a member of the CCP 14th Central Committee since Oct 1992.
