Joint declaration of the PR China and the Russian Federation on the basic principles governing their bilateral relations.

Full text:

1) The two parties are of the view that to raise their bilateral relations to a new level and further strengthen and develop them accords with the fundamental interests of the two peoples and contributes to peace and stability in Asia and the world at large.

2) The People's Republic of China and the Russian Federation regard each other as friends. They will develop friendly and good-neighbourly relations and mutually beneficial cooperation in accordance with the UN Charter, the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, mutual non-aggression, non-interference in each other's internal affairs, equality and mutual benefit and peaceful coexistence, and other universally accepted norms of international law.

The two parties emphasize that the right of a people to choose freely a road to development for their country should be respected and that differences in social system and ideology should not affect the normal growth of state-to-state relations.

3) The two parties affirm that all disputes between the two countries should be resolved by peaceful means. Neither party should resort to force or threat of force in any form against the other party, including the use of the territorial land, water and air space of a third country bordering the other party. For that purpose, a mechanism of dialogue should be established.

4) Neither party should join any military or political alliance against the other party, sign any treaty or agreement with a third country prejudicing the sovereignty and security interests of the other party, or allow its territory to be used by a third country to infringe on the sovereignty and security interests of the other party.

5) Proceeding from its recognition of the government of the People's Republic of China as the sole legal government representing the whole China and Taiwan as an integral part of Chinese territory, the Russian Federation shall not maintain any official ties or contracts with Taiwan. The economic, scientific-technological and cultural exchanges between Russia and Taiwan shall be conducted on a non-governmental basis.

6) Both parties wish to see the UN's role and prestige enhanced and the purposes and principles of the UN Charter effectively implemented. They call for the observance of the norms of international law, the maintenance of international peace and security and the prevention of armed conflicts. The two parties shall actively engage in consultation with each other within the framework of the UN and shall attach importance to the consultation and cooperation within the UN Security Council and among its permanent members.

7) The two parties reaffirm that neither China nor Russia will seek hegemony in the Asia-Pacific region or any other region in the world. They are opposed to hegemonism and power politics in any form.

8) The two parties believe that international disarmament agreements that serve the interest of international peace, security and stability will contribute significantly to improved international situation. They oppose any arms race and will take measures to strengthen the nuclear non-proliferation regime and to prevent the proliferation of other weapons of mass destruction. The two parties reiterate that under no circumstances will they be the first to use nuclear weapons, or use or threaten to use such weapons against non-nuclear-weapon states and nuclear-weapon-free zones.

9) The two parties shall work to promote peace, security, stability and prosperity in the Asia-Pacific region and facilitate the implementation of bilateral and multilateral cooperation schemes that may help enhance mutual understanding among North-East Asian countries and promote their economic development.

10) The two parties shall expand their bilateral consultations on international issues. Such consultations shall cover, inter alia, consolidation of peace and security, promotion of cooperation in

Asia and the world, solutions to major global and regional issues and other issues of common interest.

11) For the purpose of promoting bilateral relations, mutual trust and understanding, the two parties agree to maintain regular political dialogues at various levels, including high-level meetings and close cooperation between the foreign ministries of the two countries.

The two parties shall take necessary measures to expand exchanges between the legislative, judicial and executive organs at the central and local levels and between social organizations of the two countries.

12) The two parties shall, proceeding from the relevant treaties which resulted in the present China-Russia boundaries and in accordance with the established norms of international law, continue their negotiations, in the spirit of consultation on an equal footing, mutual understanding and mutual accommodation, on the unsettled boundary sections between the People's Republic of China and the Russian Federation so as to find a fair and reasonable solution to the boundary question.

13) Both parties hold the view that the military forces in the Sino-Russian border areas should be reduced to the minimum level commensurate with the normal and good-neighbourly relations between the two countries. The two parties reaffirm that the agreement reached between the governments of China and the Soviet Union on 21st April 1990 shall serve as the basis for the negotiations and they will take concrete measures and make positive efforts to build up their mutual confidence and maintain tranquility in the border areas.

14) The two parties shall maintain military contracts according to the usual international practice so as to build up their mutual confidence and cooperation in the military field. To this end, exchange programmes shall be formulated and implemented.

15) The two parties shall cooperate in judicial assistance in civil and criminal cases and see to it that citizens of one party enjoy, in the territory of the other, the rights as stipulated in the existing relevant bilateral agreements and those arising from their respective international obligations relating to judicial assistance.

16) The two parties are ready to maintain and develop their cooperation in bilateral trade on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

The two parties shall create favourable conditions for the trade ties within the framework of the agreements and protocols between the two countries and for the direct trade between regions of the two countries including border areas, and that between their enterprises, organizations and businessmen.

The two parties shall work to promote their economic and financial cooperation and vigorously strengthen bilateral economic ties. Such cooperation shall cover areas of great importance to the two countries such as agriculture, biotechnology, energy, utilization of nuclear energy for peaceful purposes including nuclear safety, transportation, infrastructures, communications and telecommunications, peaceful use of outer space, conversion of military industries to civil industries, and retail trade.

The two parties shall encourage new forms of economic cooperation and create favourable conditions for them, especially in investment and joint ventures. They shall help raise the efficiency of their respective economic organizations and, to this end, exchange, as much as possible, economic information with each other and make it available to industrialists and scholars of the two countries.

17) The two parties shall strengthen their cooperation in the scientific and technological field, including research in basic and applied sciences and the spread of the research findings, increase the exchange of scientific and technological information and the number of cooperative projects in their respective priority areas, and facilitate the implementation of those programmes involving a third country. The two parties shall promote direct contracts in the scientific and technological field between Chinese and Russian organizations, scientific research institutes, institutions of higher learning, scientific research and production amalgamations and companies.

18) The two parties are ready to enhance their cooperation in environmental protection and strengthen coordination in the framework of multi-lateral cooperation.

19) The two parties shall promote and expand interflow in the fields of culture, arts, education, information, tourism and sports as well as exchanges between the youth of the two countries. They shall encourage direct exchanges between cultural organizations of the two countries and contacts between their citizens.

The two parties believe that the teaching of each other's language and literature is of great importance and shall cooperate in the training of cultural cadres, protection of national cultural heritage, translation, publication and intercollegiate exchanges.

20) The two parties shall cooperate in cracking down on organized crimes and fighting international terrorism, illegal trafficking of drugs and weapons, and smuggling (including the smuggling of articles of historical or literary value and endangered animal and plant species).

21) The contents of this declaration shall in no way effect the obligations of each of the two parties to a third country, nor is it directed against any third country.

CHINA'S ECONOMIC AID

Nepal

The Gorakhali Rubber Plant built with Chinese technology and equipment was inaugurated by King Birendra on Dec 10, 1992. Located more than 120 kilometers west of Kathmandu, the rubber plant has ended the history of Nepal's entire dependence on the international market for the supply of rubber tires. The factory is designed to produce 88,000 standard sets of truck, bus, jeep and car tires annually, with relatively low prices and high quality. The products fell short of the demand in Nepal with some being exported to Bangladesh.

Pakistan

The construction of a 300-Megawatt nuclear power plant was inaugurated at Chashma in Mianwali District of Pakistan's Punjab Province on Dec 26, 1992. The Chashma Nuclear Power Plant is being supplied by China under a contract signed between the two countries in Beijing on Dec 31, 1991. Basic design work of the project has been completed and a preliminary safety analysis is expected to be ready soon. The Chashma Nuclear Power Plant will be Pakistan's second power plant after Karachi Nuclear Power Plant which was commissioned in 1972.

Ding has been director of the Department of Unity Front Work under the CCP Central Committee since Nov 1990 and member of Politburo of the CCP 14th Central Committee since Oct 1992.

Gu Linfang 顾林芳
Appointed inspector-general of the People's Police.

(XNA, Dec 12, 1992)
Gu was born in 1928 in Jiangsu Province. He once served in the 3rd Field Army. Later he served in security departments and finally was made vice-minister of public security in May 1988.

Gu Shanqing 谷善庆
Identified as political commissar of Beijing Military Region.

(Hongkong Hsin Pao, Dec 18, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 22, 1992)
Gu, a lieutenant-general of the PLA, has been political commissar of Chengdu Military Region before. He was elected member of the CCP 14th Central Committee in Oct 1992.

Guo Chaoren 郭超人
Appointed director-general and CCP secretary of XNA.

(Hongkong TKP, Dec 3, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 8, 1992)
Guo was born in 1934 in Hubei Province and graduated from Beijing University in 1956. Successively, he served as an XNA reporter in Tibet and Shaanxi. He became deputy director-general of XNA in Aug 1984 and a member of the CCP Central Committee in Nov 1987.

Jia Chunwang 贾春旺
Appointed inspector-general of the People's Police.

Jia has been minister of state security and member of the CCP Central Committee since Sep 1985.

Jiang Hongquan 姜洪泉
Identified as deputy commander of Beijing Military Region.

(Hongkong Ching Chi Jih Pao, Dec 22, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 24, 1992)
Jiang has been deputy commander of Chengdu Military Region and commander of Tibet Military District before.

Jin Jipeng 金基鹏
Appointed deputy auditor-general of the Auditing Administration.

(XNA, Dec 23, 1992)
Jin, who was born in 1934 in Nanjing, has been governor and deputy Party secretary of Qinghai Province before.

Li Zhijian 李志坚
Elected deputy secretary of Beijing CP.

(XNA, Dec 17, 1992)
When elected member of the Standing Committee of Beijing CP in 1987 Li was a newcomer. Since 1988 he also has been serving as director of the Propaganda Department of Beijing CP.

Liu Anyuan 刘安元
Identified as political commissar of Nanjing Military Region.

(Xinhua Ribao, Nov 22, 1992; cit. SWB, Nov 27, 1992)
Liu was born in 1927 in Shandong Province. He once served in the 4th Field Army. He served as political cadre in PLA units and became political commissar of Guangzhou Military Region in 1985. From 1987 until 1990 he served as political commissar of the PLA General Logistics Department. Since then he has been political commissar of the PLA Second Artillery. Since Nov 1987 he also has been a member of the CCP Central Committee.

Liu Lunxian 刘伦贤
Identified as deputy commander of Nanjing Military Region.

(Xinhua Ribao, 27.11.1992; cit. SWB, 2.12.92)
Liu was born in 1943 in Shanghai. He joined the PLA in 1961 and rose in the Nanjing Military Region to its chief of staff in 1985.

Liu Zhongde 刘忠德
Appointed acting minister of culture.

(XNA, Dec 23, 1992)
Liu was born in 1933 in Jilin Province and graduated from Harbin Polytechnical University in 1959. Until 1985 he then served in the Harbin Civil Engineering Institute. In May 1985 he became vice-minister of the State Education Commission and three years later deputy secretary-general of the State Council. Since Oct 1992 he has been deputy director of the Propagan-

da Department under the CCP Central Committee.

Lu Jian

Removed as vice-minister of justice. (XNA, Dec 23, 1992)

Ma Lisheng 马 李 胜

Removed as vice-chairman of Tibet People's Government. (Tibet TV, Dec 23, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 30, 1992)

Ma Zhongchen 马 忠 臣

Appointed acting governor of Henan Province. (Henan Broadcasting Station, Dec 18, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 24, 1992)

Ma was born in 1936 in Shandong Province. Until 1976 he served in counties of his home province. The years until 1982 he was secretary of Taian City CP. From 1986 until 1989 he worked as vice-governor of Shandong. Since Sep 1982 he has been alternate member of the CCP Central Committee and since Dec 1990 vice-minister of culture.

Ren Jianxin 任 建 新

Appointed secretary of the Central Committee of Political Science and Law and chairman of the Central Committee for Comprehensive Management of Public Security. (XNA, Dec 9, 1992)

Ren has been a member of the CCP Central Committee since Nov 1987 and president of the Supreme People's Court since Apr 1988. Since Oct 1992 he has also been a member of the Secretariat of the CCP Central Committee.

Shi Yuxiao 史 玉 孝

Identified as political commissar of Guangzhou Military Region. (XNA, Dec 11, 1992)

Shi, a member of the CCP Central Committee since Nov 1987 and a lieutenant-general, has been political commissar of Nanjing Military Region before.

Tao Siju 陶 驷 驹

Appointed inspector-general of the People's Police. (XNA, Dec 12, 1992)

Tao has been minister of public security since March 1991 and member of the CCP 14th Central Committee since Oct 1992.

Tian Chengping 田 成 平

Elected governor of Qinghai Province. (XNA, Dec 12, 1992)

Tian was born in 1945 in Daming County, Hebei Province. He graduated from the Architecture Department of Qinghua University. 1974-83 he served

in the Qianjin Chemical Works and the Beijing Yanshan Petrochemical Corporation. In Feb 1988 he became deputy secretary of Qinghai Province CP and in Oct 1992 alternate member of the CCP 14th Central Committee.

Wang Renzhi 王 忍 之

Appointed Party secretary of the Academy of Social Sciences. (XNA, Dec 7, 1992)

Wang was removed from his positions as member of the CCP Central Committee in Oct 1992 and as director of its Propaganda Department in Nov 1992.

Wang Zhaoguo

Appointed director of the Department of United Front Work under the CCP Central Committee. (XNA, Dec 30, 1992)

Wang, a member of the CCP Central Committee since Sep 1982, has been director of the Taiwan Affairs Office under the State Council before.

Xiao Jianzhang

Appointed vice-minister of justice. (XNA, Dec 23, 1992)

Xiao was a newcomer when he could be identified as director of the Justice Department under Hebei Provincial People's Government in Feb 1989.

Zeng Jianhui

Appointed director of the Information Office of the State Council. (XNA, Dec 3, 1992)

Zeng has been deputy director of the Propaganda Department under the CCP Central Committee since Oct 1988.

Zeren Sangzhu

Appointed vice-chairman of the People's Government of Tibet Autonomous Region. (Tibet TV, Dec 23, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 30, 1992)

Zeren was a newcomer when he could be identified as chairman of the Animal Husbandry and Forestry Commission of Tibet People's Government. Since Oct 1990 he has been secretary-general of this government.

Zhang Gong

Identified as political commissar of Chengdu Military Region. (Hongkong Hsin Pao, Dec 18, 1992; cit. SWB, Dec 22, 1992)

Zhang was born in 1935 in Shanxi Province. He joined the PLA in 1951 and rose in Beijing Military Region to its political commissar in June 1990. Since Mar 1988 he has been a deputy

of the PLA to the 7th NPC and a member of the CCP 14th Central Committee since Oct 1992.

Zhang Haoruo

Appointed vice-minister of light industry. (XNA, Dec 1, 1992)

Zhang resigned as governor of Sichuan Province only three days before.

Zhang Zhijian

Appointed deputy commander of Beijing Military Region and as commander of Beijing Garrison. (XNA, Dec 7, 1992)

Zhang was born in 1934 in Wenxi County, Shanxi Province. He joined the PLA in 1951 and served with the "Chinese People's Volunteers" in Korea 1953-56. Subsequently he served in Jinan Military Region to become its deputy commander in 1987.
