He served as section chief at CCP Taizhou Prefectural Committee from 1949 to 1956, director of Propaganda Department of Xin'anjiang Electric Power Engineering Bureau (until 1960), deputy director and deputy secretary of No.9 Engineering Bureau of Ministry of Electric Power from 1963 to 1974, general director and secretary of CCP Zhejiang Banshan Power Plant General Headquarters from 1974 to 1977, director of Electric Power Bureau of Zhejiang Province, vice-chairman of Zhejiang Provincial Economic Commission (until 1983), secretary of CCP Ningbo Municipal Committee from 1983 to 1988, and as Standing Committee member of CCP Zhejiang Provincial Committee from 1986 to 1988. Ge is a member of the 14th CCP CC.

**Jiang Yunbao (2)**

Appointed deputy director of the State Council Research Office. (RMRB, 16 Jan 94) He has served as director of the Premier's Office since December 1991.

**Li Laizhu (3)**

Identified as commander of Beijing Military Region. (RMRB, 4 Feb 94) He has served as deputy commander since June 1985. ### Australia (Jan 07)

A Sino-Australian broadcasting agreement was signed in Beijing by Ai Zisheng, China's minister for radio, film and television, and David Hill, managing director of Australian Broadcasting Corporation. (XNA, 8 Jan 94)

### Azerbaijan (Jan 04)

Four agreements were signed in Beijing by Chinese Vice-Premier and Foreign Minister Qian Qichen and Azerbaijan Foreign Minister G. ### Eritrea (Jan 13?)

## International Agreements
