A general introduction to this preliminary edition is to be found in the first volume.

The Samjñā-Kalpa (JK 3) is the third part of the Jaimini-Kalpa. It explains the structure and composition of the Sāmavedic liturgy in general terms and gives rules of interpretation (*paribhāṣā*) for the following Vikṛti-Kalpa (JK 4), where the liturgy of the ectype rites (*vikṛti*) is defined while using abbreviations.

I trust that this previously unknown Vedic text will be of interest not only for its information on the Sāmaveda, but also as an early example of a text presenting matters systematically and with the use of condensation, in these respects a predecessor of Pāṇini.

JK 2,25 has many more *sāmans* on JS 3,23,4-5, but the Kauthuma liturgy of the *indrastoma* (Maśaka 5,6, Caland 1908: 69) has just two *tr̥cas* on these same verses (SV 2,272-273). I have therefore assumed that this *ūrdhv_{elavanti}* consists of a *sāmatr̥ca* of three separate *sāmans* on single verses before *yaudhājayam* on a *tr̥ca*, which is the pattern of the following group in JK 3,5,15.
