Call for Submissions

Interdisziplinäre Zeitschrift für Südasienforschung (IZSAF)

We welcome academic contributions to the *Interdisziplinäre Zeitschrift für Südasienforschung* (IZSAF), the Interdisciplinary Journal of South Asian Studies. We mainly address early career researchers and scholars of all disciplines who engage with the cultures, religions and languages of South Asia and their global entanglements. IZSAF is an open-access and peer-reviewed journal which has been published annually since 2016.

Submissions should fall within the following categories:

1) Research Article

Articles of a maximum of 70 000 characters (including spaces) based on original research and addressing a current topic of South Asian Studies.

2) Essay/Research Report

Shorter scholarly pieces with a maximum of 20 000 characters (including spaces) which present planned research projects or initial results of a current research project.

3) Review Essay

Reviews of academic monographs and other publications that are relevant to current debates in South Asian Studies. Review Essays can vary between 15 000 – 50 000 characters (including spaces).

4) Photo Essay

Visual presentations of themes in South Asian Studies which are of interest to a wider audience. Photo Essays comprise of maximum of ten photographs and an accompanying text (max. 10 000 characters, including spaces).

5) News

Announcements of upcoming events from all areas of South Asian Studies, such as conferences and workshops or newly established research networks (ca. 2 000 characters, including spaces).
